

## Example First and Second Level Primary Itinerary

Aigas Wildlife

Aim: To learn about the wildlife of Scotland.

Session	Timings	Content
Arrival & introductions	10.00 – 10.20	Arrive at the Magnus house, meet the Education Team and explore the taxidermy on display. There will be time for a snack if required.
Freshwater Invertebrates	10.20 – 12.00	Explore the Aigas Loch, discovering what lives in and around it.  Search for invertebrates from our dipping platform, learn about their life cycles and how beneficial they are to our ecosystems.  Search for land invertebrates in the Aigas woods, comparing the differences between these and the animals from the loch.
Lunch	12.00 – 12.30	Lunch in the Magnus House.
Nature Walk	12.30 – 13.50	Explore the Aigas woods and moorland, searching for wildlife and playing educational games along the way. Visit the remains of a Bronze Age hut circle and imagine what life was like for the people who lived here at that time.
Finish	13.50 – 14.00	Round up and say our goodbyes.
